Please respond by filling out the order blank for *room reservations* and *Pacific Southwest Reception* tickets, and **returning the form immediately** with the full payment required. Please note that <u>all major credit cards may be used to charge room deposits</u>. This year the *Pacific Southwest Reception* tickets may be charged to <u>Discover, MasterCard or VISA only</u>. You can pay <u>all items by check</u>. *Please note:* We have been given a limited number of rooms and we are giving you this information early in order to ensure that we have a room for you.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ABOUT GRAND LODGE CONVENTION IN NEW ORLEANS

Where are we staying and how much will it cost?

We are staying at the New Orleans Marriott, 555 Canal Street, New Orleans, LA 70130. The room rate is \$112 per night plus tax currently at 13% (\$14.56) and a \$3 per night occupancy fee for a total of \$129.56.

You will need to send a one night deposit or credit card. If you have any problems, let me know. **Be** sure to put an e-mail address on the registration form. This is the only way that we will send out a confirmation notice for your room. If your arrival date changes let me know right away. If you fail to arrive on the listed arrival date, you will be charged for one night and lose your room.

What about travel arrangements?

If you fly:

You can book through the internet. There are cabs to get you to and from the airport to the hotel for about \$30.

Car Rental?

Again I suggest that you get on the internet and find the best deal. Normally Dollar or Budget have good rates. It seems that there is little competition between companies.

When should you arrive?

We suggest that you plan to arrive on Saturday, July 12th. This will give you an opportunity to get settled in and see the town. The Opening Ceremonies are on Sunday afternoon, July 13th and checking in on that day may present a problem. We also suggest that you plan on staying over on Thursday, July 17th in order to avoid the rush. If you must leave on Thursday, be sure to book your flight late enough so that you stay through the closing ceremonies. You can store your luggage with the Bell Desk or arrange for a late checkout. We will also have a place designated in the lobby (still in negotiations) to leave your luggage until you leave for the airport. I have found over the years that you will be quite busy at the convention and Thursday afternoon will be a great time to see the sites and relax before going home.

How close are we to the Convention Center and Headquarters Hotel?

Convention Center is about a 20 minute walk and we are staying in the headquarters hotel. The co headquarters hotel is the Sheraton located across the street.

What functions are planned for the convention and how much will they cost?

- 1. Sunday Opening Ceremony (3:00 p.m.) at the convention center in Hall F
- 2. Registration and exhibits will be set up at the convention center in Hall E
- 3. Ritual Contest will be set up at the convention center
- 4. District Deputies Designate Seminar will be held at the convention center on Tuesday, July 15th
- 5. Exalted Ruler's Ball will be held on Wednesday evening, July 16th, at the Sheraton
- 6. Transportation will be provided to all Grand Lodge functions from hotels in the Grand Lodge Block.

These events are subject to change and the times may be a little off. Be sure to check the Elks Magazine June issue for exact information. This will give you some idea of what to expect if this is your first convention. You will also be receiving a program of events when you register. The badge(s) you receive at registration, which is \$50 (including spouse), is your ticket for admission to all events and meetings with the exception of the *Pacific Southwest Reception*.

Is there anything else to do while we are in New Orleans?

Don't mention shopping to Bonnie. There is lots of sightseeing. You might want to try the trolley; \$3 gets you a pass that is good for the entire day. Other things you might want can be found with the concierge desk. They are very helpful and prices that they arrange for you are the cheapest.

What do I do if I need assistance due to disability?

If you need assistance due to disability, please submit a letter describing the type of assistance that is needed. This letter should be attached to your room reservation. I will pass this information along to the Grand Lodge National Convention Office. This information will assist in making appropriate transportation and wheelchair availability arrangements. We will also be able to arrange for appropriate housing for you at the hotel.

What about hospitality needs?

There is a COSTCO located three miles from the hotel and a supermarket is also close by. The prices seem to be about the same as California.

What to do if there is a problem?

We will have people available in the main lobby of the New Orleans Marriott on Monday, July 14th from 10:00 to 2:00. You can pick up your *Pacific Southwest Reception* tickets at that time. If you fail to pick them up, don't panic. We will have them for you at the door. If you need to contact me at any other time, call my room. I will be in the New Orleans Marriott beginning on Tuesday, July 8th if you need to reach me. The concierge desk is located in the lobby of the hotel and is very able in assisting guests of the hotel. There is a charge that is waived for Elks.

What are the Special Events?

<u>Tuesday July 15th - Pacific Southwest Reception/Grand Lodge Reception ~ 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.</u> Grand Ballroom, New Orleans Marriott

This is a don't miss party for the members of the California-Hawaii Elks Association. The cost for this event is \$50 per person and includes buffet dinner and two drinks per person. We will be experiencing the food of New Orleans. Remember, you can put the cost of this event on your Discover, MasterCard or VISA. This event will be held at the New Orleans Marriott in the Grand Ballroom. This year we will be honoring the state presidents of California-Hawaii, Arizona, Nevada, and Utah along with the sponsors of Area 7, PGER Ken Moore and Rosemary, PGER Jim Grillo and Lucia, and PGER Tom Brazier and Venita.

Anything else I should know?

All rooms have hair dryers, irons and coffee pots. There are mini refrigerators available for a small charge. These may be requested from the hotel upon your arrival. The food in the hotel is excellent, but a little pricy. There are many good and cheap restaurants very close to the hotel.

It is very important that you have the opportunity to attend the functions.

If you have other Elks that wish to attend the convention, registration forms are available on the CHEA website (chea-elks.org). We try to get all of the Elks from each district located on the same floor. Reservations received after June 13, 2014 will be accepted based on availability at the convention rate

This is going to be a great convention that you will not soon forget. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions.
