



As you know, many Lodges hold funds for the Purple Pig and ENF so they can make a big donation. By holding these funds in your own accounts, you are getting 1/2% or less in interest. By sending the funds to Fresno, it goes to work earning 7 to 9% interest.

Grand Lodge has recently addressed the issue of holding funds in the following statute:

GLS 13.022 Op 01: Funds received by a Lodge for the specific use of the Elks National Foundation or a State Major Project should be promptly forwarded to the designated beneficiary. To do otherwise defeats the impact and timeliness of the gift and frustrates the intent of the donor.

This year Lodges are to report monthly their funds to the District Chair along with sending in the Monthly Awards Report (MARs) to Fresno. Let's keep those funds and MARs going to Fresno each and every month. There will be a change coming to the Leading Knights Challenges; watch for details in the future.

- Mulligans: \$20 Buy-in good for for one mulligan on the front and one on the back each day.
- <u>Paint sticks</u>: \$20 per stick which allows for a "gimmie" putt within the length of the stick once on each nine of each day.
- DRESS CODE: Shirts with collars, no denim, no cut-offs, soft spikes only.
