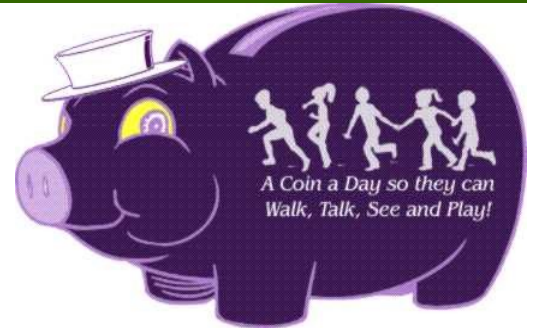

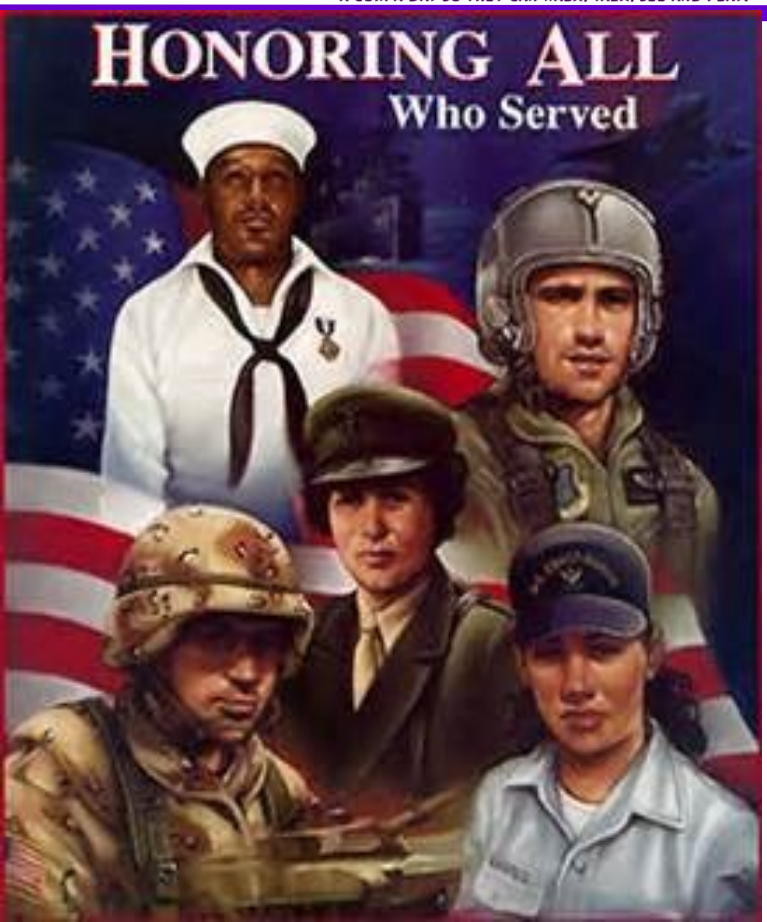

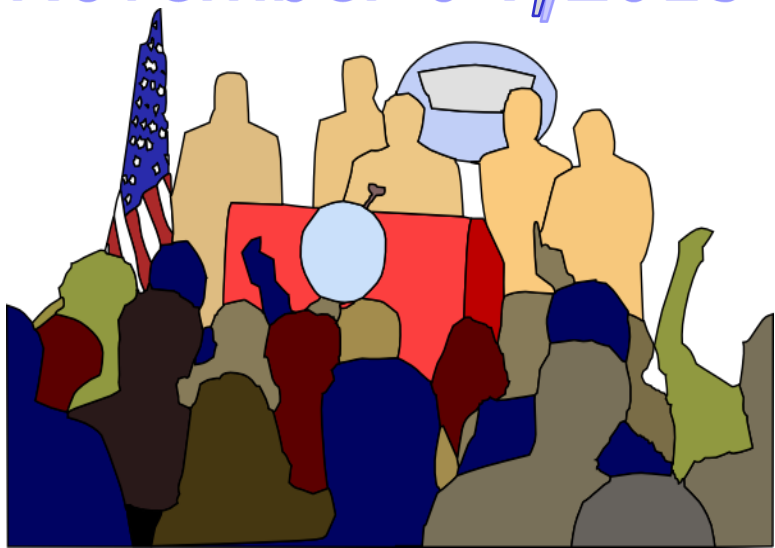
Temecula Valley Elks #2801 August BLT Night
