## The purpose of the Drug Awareness Essay Contest is to involve children, schools and parents in the Drug Awareness Program.

## ESSAY RULES:

- 1. All Students in the 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, & 8<sup>th</sup> grades are eligible to participate. Participants must write the essay themselves, but they may get help from teachers, parents or friends in the form of ideas.
- 2. Essays are to be 250 words or less and typed, computer generated text, hand written or hand printed on 8 ½ by 11-inch paper.
- 3. Each Lodge submits the three top essays to the District Chairperson based on the dates established by the District Chairperson.
- 4. Each District Chairperson submits <u>one original essay</u> to the CHEA DAP (Drug Awareness Program) Chairperson as the first-place winner for their District.
- 5. Essays must be received by the CHEA DAP Chairman, from the District Chairman no later than January 15, 2025.
- 6. All entries become the sole property of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks and will not be returned.
- 7. Each winning essay should be attached to the completed Essay Contest Entry Form. The following information must be included on the Entry Form:
  - Name of StudentsAge and Gender of StudentGrade of StudentHome Address of StudentTelephone Number of StudentTeacher's NameName of Student's SchoolElks Lodge Name and NumberMust also be accompanied by Parental Consent Form Waiver.
- 8. Each Essay must be attached to the Parental Consent Form Waiver and Essay Contest Entry Form attached.
- 9. Judging will be based on the following:
  - A. Is the essay based on the theme?
  - B. Is it original?
  - C. Is it neat?
  - D. Is it grammatically correct and are words spelled correctly?
- 10. Each State Drug Awareness Chairman will choose one overall winner. This winning essay will be submitted for entry into the National contest and may be featured on the <u>www.elkskidszone.org</u> website and/or in ENF or DAP publications.
