#### **VOCATIONAL GRANT APPLICATION, 2025**

Grants range from \$500 to \$1,000, with a two-year \$2,000 maximum.

#### **APPLICATION CHECKLIST**

 The application completed signed and dated by Benevolent Protective Order of Elks Lodge Scholarship Chair, the Exalted Ruler, or the Lodge Secretary.
Statement from applicant – A signed and dated letter from the applicant of not more than 350 words, summarizing the activities and accomplishments which the applicant thinks qualify him or her for a grant. This letter must include the needs and objectives of the student and outline career goals and course plans.
 Transcript of grades or work record for the past 2 years. (Armed Forces, Vocational Aptitude test scores may also be included). If you have been out of school or work for more than 2 years, write a statement explaining the circumstances and attach it to this application.
 A letter from the school you have selected to attend, attesting that the vocational course of study is available and that you are qualified to enter on the dates you have chosen.
 Pamphlet or letter from the school showing details of the course of study you want to take. You may add other information to this application that may be helpful.

**WHO MAY APPLY:** Any prospective student residing within the California-Hawaii Elks Association (CHEA) jurisdiction who plans to pursue an eligible vocational/technical course may apply. Persons enrolling in a 4-year course leading to a Bachelor's degree are NOT eligible. All applicants must be citizens of the United States of America on the date the application is filed.

WHAT PROGRAMS ARE ELIGIBLE? An eligible program shall be defined as a two-year or less vocational/technical program, culminating in an associate degree, diploma, certificate, or other evidence of completion. This grant may not be used for

courses at or below the high school level. If work-related certification or recertification is required, the job must require a high school diploma or equivalent, and the school must be in the United States and have received accreditation within the industry, or by either the U.S. Federal Department of Education or the Council of Higher Education Accreditation.

WHERE TO FILE: This application must be filed with the Lodge Scholarship Chair, Exalted Ruler, or Lodge Secretary of the Elks Lodge having jurisdiction in the area where the student has legal residence. To find the Elks Lodge in your area, go to www.elks.org\_and use the "Lodge Locator" and your legal residence zip code. Only one application may be filed. Students eligible for the optional Second Year Award must submit a second verification of enrollment form the second year.

HOW DOES THIS GRANT WORK? The grants range from \$500 to \$2,000. Each grant is for one year, with an option to renew for one more year. The sum of both years could be up to \$2,000. After the CHEA Scholarship Committee approves, the Fresno office of the California-Hawaii Elks Association (CHEA) makes payments to the school. Payments are conditional upon the student's enrollment in the vocational/technical course in the school, as shown on the application. Payments cannot be made directly to the student. Upon the Elk's receipt of the "Verification of Enrollment" form completed by the proper school officials, a California Hawaii Elks Association check will be forwarded to the school to establish a credit for the student for that school year. Payments may not be used to cover charges incurred before grant approval. Unexpended credit is subject to withdrawal if the student's conduct contradicts the principles of law and order and morality supported by the Order of Elks. The grant may also be withdrawn if the course of study changes. Students cannot receive more than one Elks Association scholarship/grant in any fiscal year (April 1st - March 31st).

The grant may be used for tuition, fees, room and board (if living on campus), books, and supplies. It may be used only for the usual and required costs of a student's planned courses. It may not be used for general living expenses such as apartment rent, mortgage payments, car, or childcare costs.

**WHEN TO APPLY:** Submit your completed application to your local Elks Lodge before your course begins and the school requires payment. The application must be submitted within one month of receiving or downloading the application because the California Hawaii Elks reserves all rights to change the program.

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** Typewritten applications and statements are preferred over handwritten submissions. On budget, round off to the nearest dollar. Applications and all supporting documents must be written in English or translated into English. Use additional sheets if needed. After completing the applicant's portion of the application, you are recommended to make a copy for your records. Electronic applications cannot be processed at this time. The neatness and completeness of the application can be used to evaluate the application. All applications become the property of the California-Hawaii Elks Association and will not be returned.

The CHEA Vocational Grant Committee will notify applicants via US Mail within 60 days of receiving the application from the local Elks Lodge to the CHEA office. Applications can be turned in to local Elks Lodges year-round; however, the CHEA-Vocational Grant Committee meets to review applications from March to December. Expect longer than 60 days response times during January and February. The grant program may end during any year when funding is exhausted or for other unforeseen reasons. Generally, applications will be reviewed by the grant committee monthly on the first day of each month. You may request expedited service, but it cannot be guaranteed.

DO NOT INCUR EXPENSES BEFORE RECEIVING WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE CHEA VOCATIONAL GRANT COMMITTEE.
